

BACK TO THE 1940s, 6th & 7th July 2024 Re-enactor Entry Form

The South Devon Railway would like to invite re-enactors to attend 'Back To The 1940s' to be held over the weekend of 6th and 7th July. Entries will be reviewed by the organiser who will reserve the right to accept or decline any application. Successful applicants will receive free entry and travel.

Re-enactors should bring a meaningful contribution to the event, by representing the era in an authentic way and interacting with the public, where suitable. Clothing can be civilian or military, but anything that could be deemed offensive is prohibited. All clothing warn at the event must be appropriate to the era and not cause offense, including SS, Gestapo, impersonators of Hitler etc.

Live firearms and ammunition are prohibited. Deactivated firearms that are appropriate are permitted with the relevant de-activation certificate only. Deactivated firearms must not be used in a manner to cause distress. Deactivation certificates must be carried at all times (by law) and must be shown to a member of the Organising Committee or any member of staff if requested.

Exhibitors can take advantage of free entry to the attractions, including live music on each day, as well as free train travel, should you wish to visit Totnes or Staverton.

Please note that camping is not available on site but there are many great local campsites nearby.
